

## **ADMISSIONS POLICY**

UNT is committed to academic excellence. In 1984, the UNT Board of Regents endorsed the concept of raising academic requirements while intensifying efforts to help students succeed academically. Subsequently, UNT has steadily increased standards for both undergraduate and graduate admissions.

## **ADMISSION STANDARDS**

Admission criteria and requirements are published in the <u>Undergraduate Catalog</u> and the <u>Graduate</u> <u>Catalog</u> and other appropriate publications.

## **HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES**

In accordance with 34 CFR 668.16(p), UNT ensures the validity of a student's high school completion by requiring official transcripts to be received directly from the student's high school (via electronic submission or postal mail) or delivered enclosed in a sealed school envelope. Additionally, UNT ensures the high school meets UNT Admission standards as found in the <u>Undergraduate Catalog</u> by confirming with the relevant department or agency in the state in which the secondary school is located.

If necessary, UNT may contact the high school directly to confirm the validity of the documentation provided or may contact the relevant department or agency in the state to ensure the validity of the high school's secondary school education status.
