New Recipient Application Guidance

SUBMISSION/DEADLINE:

- Open the Word Document and complete a typed application for submission with the required application documents. Enter an electronic signature and save the application as a PDF document.
- All documents required for the application should be scanned and emailed together in one (1) email to scholarships@unt.edu. We are unaware of a situation where applicants are unable to submit all information electronically.
- Although we do not require a copy of your current year FAFSA to apply, we encourage all students to submit the application and ensure they are positioned to take advantage of available programs that will assist with educational expenses.
- Completed applications with required supplemental documentation must be received by UNT Financial Aid & Scholarships by **May 16, 2025**, to be considered. *Incomplete or fraudulent applications will not be considered.*

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must attend an accredited institution of higher education.
2. Applicants must meet the minimum entrance and continuing academic performance standards of the higher education institution they are attending.
3. Applicants must be classified as an undergraduate student in one of the degree programs offered by the institution (freshman and sophomore students may enroll as "undecided majors").
4. Applicants must maintain full-time enrollment unless the student is nearing completion of their degree and has less than 24 semester hours remaining in his/her degree plan.

Note: Scholarship recipients must complete an appeal for less than full-time enrollment

5. Applicants must submit the following with their completed application:
 - a) official high school or college transcripts (including all transfer hours),
 - b) two letters of professional recommendation from teachers or employers who are non-family members,
 - c) essay that includes professional goals and need for scholarship funding (two-page maximum, typed, double-spaced),
 - d) a copy of the death certificate and/or obituary as applicable.
6. Completed application with supporting documents must be submitted electronically as noted above.
