SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS/DEADLINE:

- Create an application: open a Word Document and complete typed application. To complete the application, enter an electronic signature and save the application as a PDF document.
- Scan and create a separate PDF of an official college transcript(s) from the prior academic year. All colleges have a process to request an official transcript. When you request and receive an official transcript via email, open it and create a PDF for this application. NOTE: Links to external sites to access transcripts are not acceptable to meet the application requirement.
- PDFs of the application and transcript should be merged into one document and emailed to **scholarships@unt.edu**. Please note: Only complete PDF submissions will be considered. We are unaware of a situation where applicants are unable to submit all information electronically.
- Although we do not require a copy of your current year FAFSA to apply, we encourage all students to submit the application and ensure they are positioned to take advantage of available programs that will assist with educational expenses.
- Completed submissions must be received by UNT Financial Aid & Scholarships by **May 15, 2026**, to be considered. *Incomplete or fraudulent applications will not be considered.*

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must attend an accredited institution of higher education and meet the minimum entrance and continuing academic performance standards of the higher education institution they are attending.

Applicants must be classified as an undergraduate student in one of the degree programs offered by the institution (freshman and sophomore students may enroll as “undecided majors”).

Applicants must maintain full-time enrollment unless the student is nearing degree completion and has less than 24 semester hours remaining in their degree plan. Note: Scholarship recipients must complete an appeal for less than full-time enrollment

Non-UNT submissions must include an official college transcript(s) from the prior academic year.

Completed application and supporting documentation must be submitted electronically.
