

Paying for Books

Can I use my refund to pay for books?

Yes. Books are considered an educational expense, so your refund can be applied toward the purchase of your books. Refunds are allocated to students who have an overage of financial aid after tuition, fees and on campus charges are paid.

What if I do not have a refund?

You will have to purchase your books out of pocket.

If you cannot afford to purchase your books out of pocket at this time, or are waiting to complete the financial aid process, you can contact UNT's Student Money Management Center to discuss the resources available to help pay for books.
